Coming off a recent performance of what each band member states as their "Best Show", HOT FOR TEACHER is geared up and ready to rock hometown San Francisco staple club venue Boz Scagg's Slim's. The show is slated for Saturday September 20, 2008. HFT has also teamed up with original acts White Witch Canyon featuring Tim Narducci of SpiralArms and former HFT bassist Aaron Leigh, Zen Vendetta who opened recently for UFO on their 2008 Tour, and closing the night the beautiful and highly talented "shred mistress" Gretchen Menn of Zeperella (formerly of AC/DShe) and her original act Sticks and Stones at Slim's in San Francisco. Tickets are \$13.00/adv and 15.00/door.

Friday September 26 HFT will be headlining "Street Vibrations" at John Asquaga's Nugget in the Celebrity Showroom. Tickets are \$20.00 to the general public.

Saturday October 11, HFT will also be doing another show for Fleet Week and their friends and very Special Guests, the Blue Angels at 19 Broadway in Fairfax with Who Too closing the night. Tickets are \$15.00 to the general public and \$10.00 for ALL School and Military employees (with identification).

Friday, October 31st, HOT FOR TEACHER will be teaming up with friends and Police tribute Stung for a Halloween Extravaganza featuring the 2 "Top Grossing Rock Acts of 2008"; Van Halen and The Police. A "Best in Show Costume Contest" with cash and other prizes is slated for the 2 band bill intermission. Tickets are only \$15.00.

Formed in 1999 to showcase Van Halen's David Lee Roth-era hits, HOT FOR TEACHER has been relentlessly performing throughout the western United States, thrilling concert-goers and generating legions of dedicated fans every time their raucous rock and roll flying circus rolls into town.

HOT FOR TEACHER features four explosive performers that not only are among the most talented musicians on the West Coast, they are also dedicated scholars of the Van Halen musical legacy. These rock and roll ninjas bring to the stage everything fans of the world's greatest party band crave, including roaring lead vocals, note-for-note renditions of Eddie Van Halen's most stunning guitar riffs and solos, thundering bass, massive drums, and, best of all... *one hell of a good time!*

When HOT FOR TEACHER was invited to perform for Michael Anthony's bass guitar dedication at San Francisco's Hard Rock Cafe in 2003, the already frenzied crowd was pushed into sheer delirium when the mighty bassist stepped on stage with HOT FOR TEACHER and ripped through a white-hot set featuring "Unchained," "Dance the Night Away," "Panama," and countless other Van Halen hits. HOT FOR TEACHER is often joined onstage by other rock legends as well, a group that so far has included Pat Travers, Brad Gillis (Night Ranger), Joey Alves (Y&T), Eric Martin (Mr. Big), Peter Frampton, and members of Blues Traveler, Creedence Clearwater Revisited, and Tesla.

HOT FOR TEACHER has been featured in magazines such as FHM, and news periodicals such as The Contra Costa Times and The San Jose Mercury News (and their related papers). The band also appears regularly on radio stations such as San Francisco's 107.7 "The Bone", San Jose's 98.5 KFOX, and Los Angeles' KLOS 95.5 (on the syndicated Mark and Brian Show), as well as in rock radio markets spanning Nebraska to Hawaii.
